

1 The club will be called: Cycle Seahaven *Community Amateur Sports Club (remove)*

2 The Purposes of the Club

The purposes of the Club are to promote *the amateur sport of (remove)* cycling and improve cycling infrastructure (add) in Seahaven, which encompasses Seaford, Newhaven and Peacehaven, and encourage (add) community participation in the same area.

4 Membership

- a Membership of the Club shall be open to anyone interested in cycling (add) the sport (remove) on application regardless of sex, age, disability, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, religion or other beliefs. However, limitation of membership according to available facilities is allowable on a nondiscriminatory basis.
- b The Club may have different classes of membership and subscription on a non-discriminatory and fair basis. The Club will keep subscriptions at levels that will not pose a significant obstacle to people participating.
- c The Club Committee may refuse membership, or remove it, only for good cause such as a proven case of (add) conduct likely to endanger others, disruptive behaviour, or any other action (add) bringing the Club *or sport* into disrepute.

Appeal against refusal or removal may be made to an appointed panel consisting of club members.

5 All General Meetings (remove)

- A All members may attend all general meetings of the Club in person.
- B Such meetings need 21 clear days' notice to members
- C The quorum for all general meetings is 10 members present or 10% of the total membership whichever is greater.
- D The Chair or (in his or her absence) another member chosen at the meeting shall preside.
- E Except as otherwise provided in these Rules, every resolution shall be decided by a simple majority of the votes cast on a show of hands.
- f Formalities in connection with General Meetings (such as how to put down resolutions) shall be decided by the Committee and publicised to Club members.

5 Data Protection GDPR (add).

- a The data kept by the Club will be strictly in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations 2018 and Cycle Seahaven Data Protection policies.
- b It will be the responsibility of the Data Protection Officer to ensure that all information on club members is retained securely

6 Annual General Meetings (AGM)

The Club will hold an AGM once in every calendar year and not more than 15 months after the last AGM. At every AGM:

- a All members may attend all meetings of the club in person (add)
- b Such meetings need 21 clear days' notice to members (add)
- c The quorum for AGM's is 10 members present or 10% of the total membership whichever is greater (add)
- d The Chair or (in his or her absence) another member chosen at the meeting shall preside (add)
- e The Members will elect a Committee including a Chair, Treasurer and Secretary to serve until the next AGM
- f Except as otherwise provided in these Rules, every resolution shall be decided by a simple majority of the votes cast on a show of hands (add)
- g The Treasurer will produce accounts of the Club for the latest financial year audited as the Committee shall decide;
- h The Committee will provide information (add) present a report (remove) of the Club's activities since the previous AGM;
- i The Committee (add) Members will appoint a suitable person to audit the accounts; and
- j The Members will discuss and vote on any resolution (whether about policy or to change the Rules) and deal with any other business put to the meeting.
- k Formalities in connection with AGM shall be decided by the Committee and publicised to Club members (add)
- Any Other Business must be declared to the Secretary fourteen days before the meeting (add)

7 Extraordinary General Meetings (EGM)

An EGM shall be called by the Secretary within 14 days of a request to that effect from the Committee or on the written request of not less than 10 members signed by them. Such an EGM shall be held on not less than 14 days or more than 21 days' notice at a place decided upon by the Committee or in default by the Chair.

- a All members may attend all meetings of the club in person (add)
- b The quorum for EGM's is 10 members present or 10% of the total membership whichever is greater (add)
- c The Chair or (in his or her absence) another member chosen at the meeting shall preside (add)
- d Except as otherwise provided in these Rules, every resolution shall be decided by a simple majority of the votes cast on a show of hands (add)
- e Formalities in connection with AGM shall be decided by the Committee and publicised to Club members (add)

8 The Committee

A Role

Subject to these Rules the Committee shall have responsibility for the management of the Club, its funds, property and affairs.

B **Property etc**

- a The property and funds of the Club cannot be used for the direct or indirect private benefit of members other than as reasonably allowed by the Rules.
- b The Club may provide sporting and related social facilities, sporting equipment, coaching, courses, insurance cover, medical treatment, event expenses, post event refreshments and other *ordinary* benefits. *of*Community Amateur Sports Clubs as provided for in the Finance Act 2002. (remove)
- c The Club may also in connection with the sports purposes of the Club:
- Sell and supply food, drink and related sports clothing and equipment;
- Employ members (though not for riding) and remunerate them for providing goods and services, on fair terms set by the Committee without the person concerned being present;
- Pay for reasonable hospitality for visiting teams and guests;
- Indemnify the Committee and members acting properly in the course of the running of the Club against any liability incurred in the proper running of the Club (but only to the extent of its assets).
 - d The Committee will have due regard to the law on disability discrimination and child protection.

C Composition etc

- a The Committee shall consist of at least 3 and not more than 12 members (including Officers).
- b The Committee members may co-opt club members (up to the maximum permitted number) to serve until the end of the next AGM.
- c If an Officer or Committee member retires or resigns from the Committee before the next AGM then the Committee may co-opt a Club member to sit as that Officer or Committee Member with full voting rights, until the next AGM. The post must then be put for election as in rule 6e. (add)
- d Any Committee member may be re-elected or re-co-opted without limit.
- e A Committee member ceases to be such if he or she ceases to be a member of the Club, resigns by written notice, or is removed by the Committee for good cause after the member concerned has been given the chance of putting his/her case to the Committee with an appeal to the club members, or is removed by club members at an AGM or EGM. The Committee shall fairly decide time limits and formalities for these steps.

D Committee meetings

- a Whenever a Committee member has a personal interest in a matter to be discussed, he/she must declare it, withdraw from that part of the meeting (unless asked to stay), not be counted in the quorum for that agenda item and withdraw during the vote and have no vote on the matter concerned.
- b The Committee may decide its own way of operating. Unless it otherwise resolves the following rules apply:
- At least 50% of the committee members must be present for the meeting to be valid;
- Committee meetings shall be held face to face;
- The Chair, or whoever else those present choose shall chair meetings;
- Decisions shall be by simple majority of those voting;
- A resolution in writing signed by every Committee member shall be valid without a meeting; (remove)
- The chair of the meeting shall not have a casting vote.

F Disclosure

Annual club reports and statements of account must be made available for inspection by any member and all club records may be inspected by any Committee member.

- a The members may vote to wind-up the club at a specifically convened meeting, ie an EGM.
- b The Committee will then be responsible for the orderly winding-up of the Club's affairs.
- c After settling all liabilities of the Club, the Committee shall dispose of the net assets remaining to one or more of the following:
- i. To another Club with similar sports purposes which is a charity and/or
- ii. To another Club with similar sports purposes which is a registered CASC and/or
- iii. To the Club's national governing body for use by them for related community sports.
