



Cycle Seahaven Parental Consent form **in conjunction with the Cycling UK affiliated membership**

Please read and sign in the spaces below:

All participants under the age of 18 must have the consent of a parent or guardian to take part in Cycle Seahaven rides or events. Completion, initialling and signing of this form, by a parent or guardian, indicates acceptance of the Cycle Seahaven requirements listed below.

A person aged between 16 and 18 is exempt from this requirement if they are no longer living with their parent(s)/guardian(s) and they can provide documentary proof they are living as an independent adult.

Cycle Seahaven requirements for a Child/Young Persons' Participation in Cycling Activities

Children under age 13 may only ride when accompanied by a parent/guardian. During the ride the parent/guardian must at all times take responsibility for the actions of their child.

Children aged 13 to 17 may participate unaccompanied if they have parental permission and this form is completed. There is no lower age limit if accompanied by a responsible adult acting *in loco parentis*, but completion of this form remains a requirement.

4. I understand the child may cycle with other adults and/or with other children, but that there is also a possibility of the child cycling, briefly, on their own, for example during a treasure hunt (initial here _____)
5. I accept that Cycle Seahaven extends a welcome to cyclists of all ages and abilities, but there are no special provisions for children (initial here _____)
6. I acknowledge that arrangements to get the child to and from the ride are my responsibility (initial here _____)
7. I understand that event organisers or ride leaders may not have been subject to Disclosure Barring Service checks (initial here _____)
8. I consent to the ride leader(s) acting in loco parentis, if the need arises to administer emergency first aid and/or other medical treatment to the child (initial here _____)
9. I consent to club officials transporting the child in their cars if there is a requirement to do so e.g. a parent is unable to collect the child due to unforeseen circumstances (initial here _____)

I understand that Cycle Seahaven, its members, agents and other participants reserve the right to take and subsequently publish photographs during the course of an event or ride for publicity purposes (initial here _____) If you have concerns about this please speak to the ride leader or event organiser.
