- 1. **Chairs Welcome:** Denis opened the meeting by welcoming members of the committee. Denis asked for approval of Yvonne Knight as co-opted committee member. Yvonne will take over as Treasurer from 1st January 2024. Gwydion Jones is no longer a committee member following his recent resignation.
- 2. Apologies for absence: None
- 3. Minutes from previous meeting:

Thanks to Gill for taking the minutes of 14th August in Lindsay's absence, which were approved by the committee.

4. Matters Arising/Action Points Update:

- There was no statement in the previous minutes, but it was agreed in the August meeting that we would no longer have Webmaster updates as a regular agenda item. This is due to the new website roll out having been accomplished.
- Denis agreed to liaise with Purple Crimson and a new arrangement with Purple Crimson is now in place which involves cheaper costs. The committee thanked Denis for negotiating a good deal.
- Sarah to update jersey stock.
- Gill to update jersey website -Done.
- Jamie to follow up RNLI acknowledgement Done
- Lindsay to update committee on Safer C7 project.

- Viv to pay £400 to Clubs chosen charity, the Newhaven Food Bank -Done
- Denis to continue to deal with Lloyd's bank and a possible personal visit - ongoing.
- Regarding possible new digital storage for multiple users, Lindsay is happy to continue to let Cycle Seahaven use his Dropbox account after his resignation as secretary. Should this not work out Gill has investigated a paid-for Dropbox account with a 30% reduction for non-profit making organisations but this would cost approx. £2.00 per week to store and share documents with all committee members.

7. Section Leads:

a. Dr Bike:

Worked on 159 bikes.

Total donations received to date £796 less £4.64 in Sum-up fees = £791.36.

Cycle UK grant funds brought forward from last year £554.39, with current spend of £54.97, leaving an available budget of £499.42. CSH Refreshment Budget of £200 with current spend to date of £42.88, leaving available budget of £157.12.

Therefore, total expenditure so far this year is £97.85.

Dr Bike will look into having a sign written as cheaply as possible so as not to encroach on Cycling UK grant funds, to encourage more donations.

Dr Bike sold a donation bike.

The committee extends they're thanks to Jamie and the Dr Bike Team.

b. Ride Leader Coordinator.

Denis is taking on this report for the September meeting.

August Rides:

Total rides 30--(with 4 cancellations). Road Rides 15- (with 2 cancellations). MTB Rides 15- (with 2 cancellations).

2 new incidents reported.

Ride-Leader meetings. A Ride Leaders meeting was held on 21st August. Sarah and Mike Winser are planning a further meeting in October (date to be announced).

Sarah has taken on First Aid Coordinator role. 11 people have been confirmed for the First Aid at Work course on 18th November at Hailsham, and there is one place left. The cost of the course is £375 but we had a credit of £310 from a past cancelled course. Viv has paid the remaining £65.

The committee approved Daves recommendations and are delighted to announce that Tina Chambler and Michelle Baldwin are now A1 Ride Leaders. We are grateful to Tina and Michelle for stepping forward.

Welcome also to Paul Sandles as our Club Radio and First Aid Kit Monitor. Paul has located all radios and assessed they are working. First Aid kits have been delivered to Ride Leaders.

c. Membership Secretary:

Membership now stands at 349, which is five more than last meeting. 1 family re-join, one individual re-join, and one new member.
